



## Group Study Room Guidelines

These guidelines apply to the three Group Study Rooms that are located in the northeast corner of the Canton Public Library.

1. The purpose of the library's Group Study Rooms is to provide space for groups to study
2. Group Study Rooms are not to be used for social functions or "for profit" groups soliciting or selling products or services (including, home party sales, or professional services)
3. Group Study Rooms are not to be used as a depository for personal items. Those who use the rooms must occupy them. The library is not responsible for personal items left in the rooms. Items left in an unoccupied room will be considered abandoned and staff may remove them
4. Group Study Rooms are available free of charge and are open during library hours
5. Group Study Room A can accommodate a maximum of eight (8) persons, Group Study Room B six (6) persons and Group Study Room C four (4) persons
6. Since Group Study Rooms are intended for group use, single users may be asked to move
7. Violations of the Patron Code of Conduct and Responsibility or of these Group Study Room Guidelines may result in expulsion from the Group Study Room or the library at the discretion of library staff and may result in being denied future use of the rooms
