TAKE-HOME IDEAS

TALK

Who is your favorite Star Wars character? Why? Tell a family member or a librarian.

Imagine you have to persuade Darth Vader to stop being part of the dark side. How would you convince him?

SING

Check out Star Wars music at the library. Listen and imagine you are saving the galaxy.

Make up a saving-the-galaxy song. Sing it to a friend.

PLAY

Build a starship out of boxes, chairs, or whatever you like. Where will you travel?

Try "Star Wars Charades" and act out different characters. Have someone guess who you are.

WRITE

Practice writing your alphabet. Think of Star Wars words that start with each letter.

Draw your favorite Star Wars character. Then draw or write what happens to them.

Write the words "STAR WARS." Then think of other words you can make with those letters.

READ

There are many Star Wars stories to check out at the library.

Find the word "STAR" when you are out and about.
