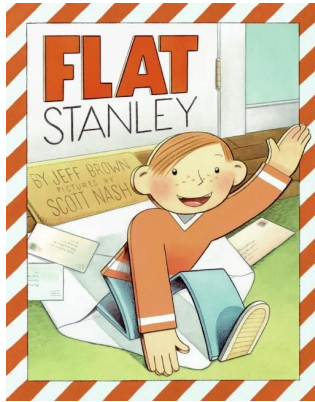

TAKE-HOME IDEAS

TALK

Flat Stanley was first published in 1964. Ask your parents, grandparents, or other family members if they read Flat Stanley when they were young. Ask them what their other favorite books were growing up.

SING

Make up a song about traveling. Where would you go? How would you get there? What would you do once you reached your destination?

PLAY

Pretend you became flat like Stanley and could mail yourself anywhere. Who would you want to visit? What would you pack in the envelope with you to take along on the journey?

WRITE

Write and mail a letter or a postcard to a family member or friend who lives in a different city.

READ

Read about a place you've never been to before, but would like to visit.
Read another book in the Flat Stanley series.
