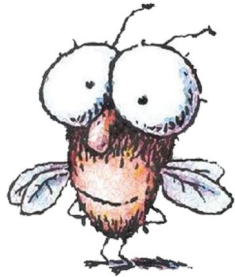


# LIT LAB PRODUCTIONS PRESENTS
